WOMEN'S CALL FOR ACTION ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PEACE AGREEMENT

A National Women's Dialogue '*The South Sudan We Want*', held in Juba on 24-25 November 2015, brought together 480 participants from across South Sudan's ten states. The dialogue presented South Sudanese women with an opportunity to exchange views and build bridges across ethnic, religious and political lines with a view to uniting and amplifying their voices in the process of implementation of the *Agreement on the Resolution of the Conflict in the Republic of South Sudan*. Represented at the Dialogue were women's organisations and networks, faith and community based organisations, the national and state governments, the diplomatic community and United Nations agencies.

1. South Sudanese women have suffered gross violations of their human rights including killings, sexual and gender based violence, displacement, destruction of property, disruption of social services and loss of livelihoods. Schools and health services have been disrupted by the conflict which broke out 15th December, 2013. Further, there has been recruitment of children into armed forces/groups.
2. In search of sustainable peace, women participated in several capacities in the IGAD and IGAD+ peace process to ensure that women's perspectives were incorporated in the outcome document – *The Agreement on the Resolution of the Conflict of the Republic of South Sudan*. Women had been acknowledged in this documents as stakeholders/adherents to the agreement, however women's participation in the implementation and monitoring structures have not been aligned with the 25% affirmative action quota in South Sudan's Interim Constitution.
3. We Welcome the agreement reached and are fully committed as stakeholders to the full implementation of the Peace Agreement in its totality, and to working with the parties to ensure sustainability of peace in South Sudan.
4. The parties to the Agreement committed themselves to the following:
 - Restoration of peace security and stability in South Sudan and to promote national healing and reconciliation
 - Protection, dignified and voluntary reintegration, repatriation, resettlement and rehabilitation of IDPs and returnees
 - Combating impunity and promoting accountability
 - Building an inclusive democratic society with respect for the rule of law
 - Ending the culture of violence as a means of resolving conflicts and promoting the culture of peace and dialogue
 - Prudent management and equitable sharing of natural and national wealth and resources of South Sudan for the promotion of the quality of life of all citizens without discrimination on grounds of gender, religion, political affiliation, ethnicity and language.
5. We recognise that a majority of the actions which should have been taken within the 3-month pre-transition period have not been implemented. We therefore demand that all the actions outlined in the agreement be implemented without further delay. In addition to the detailed implementation plan that we have developed, we call upon the parties to:
 - Call upon all women of South Sudan to unite for the implementation of the *Agreement of the Resolution of the Conflict of the Republic of South Sudan*.

- To initiate a process of promoting cohesion, investigating and prosecuting persons responsible for instigating division and hate among citizens.
- Ensure that the safety, security and livelihood concerns of women are addressed during the implementation process and include gender responsive defence and security strategies and policies.
- We affirm that 25% affirmative action within the transitional constitution must apply across the board in the implementation of the agreement where quotas are not specified.
- Ensure that the relocation of Armed forces from Juba, Malakal, Bor and Bentiu to designated areas outside the cities include their families.
- Reiterate the need for immediate demobilization, reintegration and rehabilitation of women and children associated with armed forces/groups as well as reparations.
- We call on the parties to immediately develop national and state implementation plans with clear strategies, timelines and responsibilities.
- We appreciate the work of the Women's Bloc during the peace process and now call on the parties and signatories to the agreement to ensure that representation and inclusion of women as stipulated in the agreement should be made in consultation with the women of South Sudan as a constituency.
- The spirit and letter of the peace agreement regarding women's empowerment and equality must be integrated in the permanent constitution and institutions created thereby.
- While we recognize that citizens, particularly women must understand the agreement, their responsibilities and need to demand accountability for its implementation. Therefore, resources must be provided by government and guarantors to the agreement for this purpose.

6. Finally, we recommend that qualified women be identified to take up the positions stipulated in the agreement based on an established criteria and in consultation with women.
